Professional Agreement

The main purpose of the Forestwood Skating Club (FSC), an Ohio non-profit organization, is to provide a forum for its members in which they can arrange for professional instruction in the sport of figure skating.

The duties and responsibilities of the Professionals are:

To abide by the policies and procedures of the Club, to use best efforts to secure memberships for the club, to belong to the Professional Skaters Association, to uphold high standards of the sport and profession, to work in harmony with the Professional Committee, and to enhance the development of the Forestwood Skating Clubs' skating program. The Professional further agrees to be available for meetings with the Professional Committee on reasonable notice of said meetings by the Chairman of the committee which is GraceAnn Demarest.

The parties agree that the Professional is an independent contractor responsible for his/her own Social Security and Income Taxes and is not an employee of the Forestwood Skating Club. As such, the Professional will be entitled to make arrangements for teaching lessons as he/she sees fit, limited only by the policies, rules, and regulations of the Forestwood Skating Club.

The signing of this contract by the Professional does not guarantee privileges will be granted. Acceptance or rejection of this contract is at the discretion of the Forestwood Skating Club Board of Directors. This contract is valid when signed by both the Professional and the Club President.

This contract may be terminated for causes in accordance with the rules governing discipline of a professional as set forth in the By-Laws of the Club.

The Professional may terminate this contract with 60 days written notice of such intent, unless waived by the Club.

The Board of Directors of the Forestwood Skating Club requires the following criteria be met for a Professional to teach on Club ice:

The Professional must be at least 18 years of age.

The Professional teaching freestyle must have the minimum certification required by Forestwood Skating Club and be properly trained to use the jump harness.

The Professional teaching Dance must have the minimum certification required by Forestwood Skating Club.

The Professional will adhere to the policies, rules, and regulations of the Forestwood Skating Club which is governed by the USFSA.
